I think we missionaries are the grateful ones for the opportunity to serve the Taiwan Presbyterian church wherever we were assigned, and to be welcomed so warmly by devout Christians of another culture. My family of three children all have such fond memories of living in Taichung and at Tunghai University. Thank you so very much!

I, too, am very concerned about the political environment both in this country and around the world. We see clearly that a change in regime or administration can produce unwanted changes. The Church must speak out for justice and righteousness for good to triumph over evil. I will pray also for Taiwan and the Taiwanese people as well as for the empowerment of the Church around the world.

It has been 6 years since my husband (Si Ka-ni Bok-su) died. I have been active in the church involved in prayer groups, a welcome center, and a group for single women. I also mentor a girl for Kids Hope, working with at risk children. I am blessed with good health thus far, and very grateful!
